Here are just a few of the state funding projects approved in our district recently:

- ✓ **\$2.5 million** to Clemens Food Group in Hatfield Township to construct a state-of-the-art facility.
- ✓ **\$1 million** for upgrades to Lansdale's retirement community, Elm Terrace Garden.
- ✓ **\$896,175** to supply 35 energy-efficient school buses in three counties, including Montgomery.
- ✓ **\$695,038** for infrastructure planning, construction and upgrades in our district.
- ✓ **\$250,000** for Hatfield Township's John S. Clemens Memorial Park.
- ✓ **\$122,800** for rehabilitation and development of Lansdale's Whites Road Park.

- ✓ Car registrations, special tags, disability placards, titles and driver's license applications.
- ✓ Also, you can ask us what forms you will need to bring to the DMV for various services.
- ✓ Information on financial assistance for higher education.
- ✓ Obtaining and completing all kinds of state forms.
- ✓ Unemployment compensation, disability and workers' compensation.
- ✓ Troubleshooting issues or delays with Department of Human Services (food stamps, medical and income assistance).
- ✓ PA state income tax questions or problems.
- ✓ Renewal of state-issued licenses or certifications.
- ✓ SEPTA Key Senior ID Card issues.
- ✓ Property Tax/Rent Rebate forms for seniors, widows, widowers and people with disabilities.
- ✓ PACE cards for seniors and prescription assistance.

Tours of state Capitol: Pictured with North Penn graduate and 2021 summer legislative intern Jojo Dawaldi, my office can arrange tours of the Capitol. President Teddy Roosevelt proclaimed our state Capitol the "handsomest building" he ever saw upon its dedication in 1906. Philadelphia architect Joseph Huston, the son of Irish immigrants and a Princeton University graduate, designed the Capitol's 272-foot dome, modeling it after Rome's St. Peter's Basilica. The backdrop of the Capitol's central rotunda features a grand staircase modeled after the Paris Opera House – Palais Garnier.

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES THAT HELP OUR RESIDENTS

Pennsylvania has a number of programs and services available to help families and people in our region and around the state. Some of these programs serve as lifelines to help people and families struggling, including a new program to help homeowners affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. If you have questions about any of these programs, reach out to my Lansdale office at 267-768-3671 to speak to a staff member.

Pennie: This is the Pennsylvania-run health care marketplace. If you need to shop for insurance for you and your family, pennie.com will allow you to shop different plans to address your needs.



PA Homeowners Assistance Fund: Using federal funds, this program started in February 2022 to provide assistance for homeowners negatively affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. The maximum amount of assistance for any homeowner under PAHAF is \$30,000 or up to 24 months of assistance.

Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program: This program allows seniors, widows, widowers and people with disabilities to collect a rebate on the property taxes or rent they paid in 2021. You can apply online at <https://mypath.pa.gov>.



Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program: Also known as LIHEAP, this program helps families in danger of being without heat through the form of a cash grant (up to \$1,500), which does not have to be repaid. Apply online using www.compass.state.pa.us.
