The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program – which helps eligible renters and homeowners pay their heating bills in the form of a cash grant – is once again accepting applications.

December 31 is the deadline to apply for rebates on property taxes or rent paid in 2020. The Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program is open to individuals age 65 or older; widows and widowers age 50 or older; and people with disabilities age 18 or older.
